Please pray for...

Pray for all those who were caught up in the gun attack at Bondi Beach in Australia last Sunday; the injured, the bereaved; those who tried to save lives and those traumatised by the whole experience. Hold before God all Jews who live in fear of an attack. Pray that world faith leaders will start to communicate with one another and sow the seeds of religious tolerance so that respect and acceptance will grow as a result of a better understanding of other faiths.

Pray for the on-going negotiations for peace between Ukraine and Russia. May the hearts of the leaders be committed to finding the best way forward for people they serve. Bring before God all who will be attending the special Christmas services praying that the birth of the Christ child will touch the hearts and lives of many. May this humble birth bring light, hope and joy into this dark world.
