

24 HOUR PRAYER VIGIL AT ST JOHN'S

You are invited to come in to St John's Church to **pray specifically for the advert for the new Rector of the Arle Valley Benefice**, The advert will appear on Wednesday, 4th February in the Church Times and on the Winchester Diocesan website.

We are **hoping to cover 24 hours of prayer** - this would be actually in church from 12 noon to 11pm on Saturday, 31st January and 6am to 12 noon on Sunday, 1st February, or could be done at home. The **prayer time at home need not be limited to the hours in church, but could include times between 11pm on the Saturday and 6am on the Sunday.**

If you are praying in church, you can stay as long as you like or just pop in but what we would like to achieve is commitment to 24 hours of continuous prayer. The more of us able to commit to a time is encouraging for others who may be thinking about it too. **There is a list for you to sign up for praying for a specific time either at church or home which will include the hours between 11pm and 6am for prayer at home.**

IMPORTANT APPEAL FROM THE ST. JOHN'S FINANCE TEAM

The PCC's bankers Natwest have changed the rate at which they will be charging us to run our accounts. Instead of a flat, and fairly reasonable rate, they will now be charging us per entry on our account.

Therefore we need to keep our number of financial transactions as low as possible.

This is how you can help!

If, for example you are one of our amazing volunteers who needs to **reclaim expenses**, it would be really cost effective if you were able to **'batch' small amounts and wait to claim them in one go**. Of course, if this would cause you cashflow problems just carry on as you always have.



On-line payments to the PCC cost less! (35p per electronic payment as opposed to 95p for each cheque we have to pay in, and similar for cash). So, for example, when it comes to Harvest Supper tickets, magazine renewals and all those other times when we dig out our cheque books, or purses and wallets, it really would save the church quite a large amount in bank charges if we could, if possible pay money directly (electronically) into the PCC's account.

Of course we are, as ever hugely grateful for everyone's generous monthly giving, and are still very happy to collect cash in the plate at the end of services! ***Do speak to Jon, or Jane Parsons for more details.***
