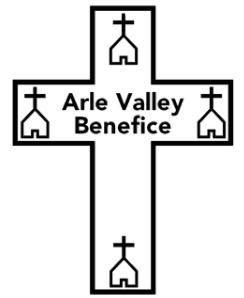

Please keep this process in your prayers.



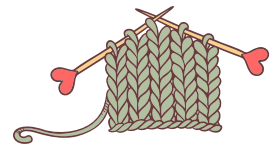
